



This epic journey takes us to Turkey, Italy, Crete and Egypt — across the very landscapes where the Māori Pioneers and the men of the 28th Māori Battalion stood, fought, sacrificed, and forged a legacy of courage that is still spoken of with deep respect around the world.

Alongside experienced local historians and hosts from Aotearoa, we will explore the battlefields in depth, ensuring the stories of the Battalion are told with context, dignity and pride.

This is also a journey of life. We will cruise the Bosphorus between Europe and Asia, wander the art-filled streets of Florence, ride gondolas in Venice, explore ancient Troy, stand before the Pyramids of Giza, share meals, laughter, and kōrero together.

We will return home not only having remembered those who served, but having honoured their legacy through connection, joy and shared experiences - affirming that their story remains part of our whakapapa and our future.

ISTANBUL - There are that many places to see in this vibrant metropolis. We'll have a 4 hour Coach tour (9am – 1pm) covering 3 of the main attractions including the Blue Mosque, Topkapi Palace and the Basilica Cistern. There is also a free day to wander the markets and explore, along with a 3 hour dinner cruise including drinks and entertainment on the iconic Bosphorus Straits. These Straits effectively divide Asia and Europe and are the main waterways from the Black Sea to the Mediterranean.



GALLIPOLI PENINSULA - where we have local guides with in-depth knowledge including specific reference to the Maori Battalion. During the day we will be visiting Beach Cemetery, ANZAC Cove, Ariburnu Cemetery and battle site, the ANZAC Commemorative Site, Mehmetcik Statue, Lone Pine Australian Memorial, Johnston's Jolly (Turkish and Allied trenches and tunnels), Turkish 57th Infantry Regiment Cemetery, The Nek battle sites and, of course, Chunuk Bair New Zealand Memorial.

TROY - is the setting for Homer's "Iliad" and the mythical Trojan War. The site contains nine distinct archaeological layers representing over 4,000 years of history, from the Bronze Age to the Roman period. During our time together we will see the ancient city walls and the replica of the famous Trojan Horse.



FLORENCE - We have a fully guided tour of the Uffizi Gallery, a former Renaissance palace, which is one of the most visited art galleries in the world. We will explore the rooms and uncover the stories behind masterpieces such as Botticelli's The Birth of Venus, Leonardo da Vinci's The Annunciation, and Michelangelo's - The Holy Family. We also visit the Galleria dell' Accademia di Firenze, home of Michelangelo's sculpture David. which was created between 1501 and 1504. It is a 17.0 ft (5.17m) marble statue depicting the Biblical hero David, represented as a standing nude male.



FAENZA - a full day coach tour to view the Faenza (21 Maori Battalion graves) and Forli (33 Maori Battalion graves) war cemeteries.


We will be accompanied by a local English speaking guide and war historian who will talk about the battlefields and the cemeteries – specifically as they pertain to the Maori Battalion.



VENICE - An absolutely magical day featuring a return trip by train to Venice. The group will break into smaller groups and we will have a walking tour of San Marco and gondola rides on the Grand Canal for all.

ROME - featuring tours including the Vatican City, the Spanish Steps, the Trevi Fountain, The Parthenon and the Roman Forum including the Colosseum. We also have a full day tour to Cassino War Cemetery (69 Maori Battalion graves) and Memorial (1 Maori Battalion soldier) and MONTE CASSINO with full battlefield and historian analysis.

CRETE - we will see the Tavronitis Bridge located in Maleme which still has visible bullet holes from intense fighting during the 1941 Battle of Crete. Nearby is the Maleme Airfield - the largest airfield on the island that was captured by the German paratroopers from the New Zealand 22nd battalion who were stationed at Hill 107 that overlooks the airstrip. We've received permission to get to the summit of Hill 107 to get a better perspective and context. We will also visit Allied War Souda Bay cemetery (25 Maori Battalion war graves) located at the Souda Bay Harbour.



CAIRO - we have a guided tour to see the Pyramids and Sphinx as well as the brand new Grand Egyptian Museum – all at Giza. There will be a Group dinner cruise on the Nile - food and drinks included.

EL ALAMEIN - visit the battlefields, the war museum and the Commonwealth War Cemetery (where 151 Maori Battalion are buried and remembered) and the memorial.

THURSDAY 8TH APRIL 2027

Departs Auckland: approximately 10pm
Arrives Istanbul: 12 noon (Friday 9 April)
On arrival at Istanbul Airport, we will be met and transferred to our central City Istanbul Hotel for the next 3 nights. Arrival into the hotel should be around 3pm, so perfect to head straight to our rooms to freshen up. Nibbles and drinks will be served in the hotel from 5pm - 6.30pm where we'll give out maps and advice about the local area. If you're exhausted and have fallen asleep, we'll have the relevant information also available at breakfast the following morning.

SATURDAY 10TH APRIL

4 hour Coach tour (9am – 1pm) covering 3 of the main attractions including the Blue Mosque, Topkapi Palace and the Basilica Cistern.

FREE AFTERNOON

SUNDAY 11TH APRIL

FREE DAY

The day itself is free to catch up on attractions missed yesterday or go to the huge markets across the bridge. Alternatively, wander around the main avenue of Istiklal with its world class shopping and take the tram down to the magnificent Galata Tower.

At 6pm we'll have a Coach take us down to the harbour and we'll have a 3 hour dinner cruise with drinks and entertainment on the iconic Bosphorus Straits. These Straits effectively divide Asia and Europe and are the main waterways from the Black Sea to the Mediterranean. We'll have a coach return us to our tour hotel around 10pm.

MONDAY 12TH APRIL

A 9.30am departure and an absolutely memorable day as our coach takes the scenic route from Istanbul to Canakkale crossing over the spectacular 1915 bridge before stopping in Canakkale, a city on the south side of the Dardanelles looking straight across the straits to the Gallipoli Peninsula. We should arrive at our centrally located hotel around 3pm after stopping en route for a sandwich and the evening is our own to further explore.

TUESDAY 13TH APRIL

It's a full day tour for the group and we'll all cross on the ferry from Canakkale to Kilitbahir (just a 15 minute crossing) where we'll be met by our hosts who have all the Gallipoli Peninsula in-depth knowledge with specific reference to the Maori Battalion.

WEDNESDAY 14TH April

Today we take a tour to ancient Troy. The site contains nine distinct archaeological layers representing over 4,000 years of history, from the Bronze Age to the Roman period. During our time together we will see the ancient city walls and the replica of the famous Trojan Horse.

THURSDAY 15TH APRIL

It's a big travelling day as we travel to Italy. Our flight will be arriving in Bologna at 2.30pm where we'll be met and driven to our hotel in central Florence (arriving around 5pm). We will have a group dinner this evening with delicious Italian food and inclusive of renowned local wines, beers, water and soft drinks.



FRIDAY 16TH APRIL

It's our first full day in Florence and we'll have a walking tour with an English speaking guide looking at the main sights of this beautiful city from 9am to 12 noon. After sitting down and stopping for a sandwich and a glass of something we will spend the afternoon visiting 2 of the most iconic galleries on the planet.

SATURDAY 17TH APRIL

We will be departing the hotel at 9am for a full day coach tour to view the Faenza and Forli war cemeteries. Lunch will be a sandwich and a glass of something.

SUNDAY 18TH APRIL

A relatively casual Sunday but after lunch we'll explore the Florence War Cemetery (25 Maori graves), again with a local guide and war historian.

MONDAY 19TH APRIL

An absolutely fascinating day as we'll have a return trip by train to Venice with the train departing Florence around 10am and returning from Venice around 7pm. Includes a walking tour of San Marco and gondola rides on the Grand Canal.

TUESDAY 20TH APRIL

For those who want a break there is the option of taking a day off to wander around Florence - the capital city of Tuscany and the birthplace of the Renaissance. Otherwise, there is a complimentary return train trip to Pisa for anyone wishing to go.

WEDNESDAY 21ST APRIL

We depart our Florence hotel at 9am and drive to Rome stopping in Siena for 90 minutes for coffee and morning tea and we should arrive into Rome around 3pm.

THURSDAY 22ND APRIL

We have a full day tour of Rome (9am until 5pm) We'll stop for a bite to eat and a drink along the way.

FRIDAY 23RD APRIL

A full day tour to Monte Cassino and War Cemetery. The day will be 9am to 5pm with lunch in Cassino included.

SATURDAY 24TH APRIL

It's a big travelling day as we'll be heading to the Greek Island of Crete. Our flight will be arriving in Chania at 2.30pm where we'll be met and driven to our hotel in Old Town Chania.

SUNDAY 25TH APRIL

After a busy few days we have a free day and time to explore this stunning city which is one of the most beautiful places in all of Europe with its Venetian Harbour, Sunday markets and the neighbouring beach and fishing port of Nea Chora, there's plenty for everyone to see and do.

MONDAY 26TH APRIL

A full day tour exploring key sites from the famous Battle of Crete. Including Tavronitis Bridge, Maleme Airfield, Hill 107 and the Allied War Souda Bay cemetery.

FRIDAY 30TH APRIL

A full day tour, 8am – 6pm where we go to El Alamein, visit the battlefields, the war museum and the Commonwealth War Cemetery.

SATURDAY 1ST MAY

It's a free day in one of the great cities of the world but we'll be on hand with ideas and to assist you. Consider visiting the Egyptian museum (established 1902) which holds the Royal Mummy room, the King Tut gallery as well as 170,000 artefacts.

SUNDAY 2ND MAY

We leave our hotel by 8.45am and head out to Cairo Airport to check-in for our flights home. Departs Cairo: approximately 12 noon. Arrives Auckland: 7.30pm (Monday 3 May)
